

Put Your Name on a Certificate

Who needs to take the Grower Pesticide Safety Course?

If you are a Grower (Farmer) and want to buy and use Schedules 1, 2, or 5 pesticides on the land you farm, you must be certified. There must be at least one Certified Grower for each farm operation.

The Ontario Ministry of the Environment recognizes you as a Grower (Farmer) if you:

1. currently use land for agricultural or forestry production, and
2. that land is classified as farmlands property under the **Ontario Assessment Act**.

To become certified, you must successfully complete the Grower Pesticide Safety Course. You must renew every five years. Put your name on a certificate.
