Trained Assistants

Certified Growers who indirectly supervise Trained Assistants must:

1. be available immediately by communication system, and
2. be able to respond to an emergency at the site within a reasonable time and
3. provide written instructions to the TA for the mixing, loading or applying of Schedule 5 pesticides
