11	<b>Biopesticides or Low-Risk</b> - These active ingredients are allowed for cosmetic use. Green signs must be posted when used in, on, or over land by 1) a licenced applicator, and 2) a person in non-residential areas.			

**\*Public Health and Safety:** (Reg. 63/09, s.17)

Anyone may use Class 5, 6, or 7 pesticides (if labelled) on their own land for these health or safety reasons to control:  
1) animals that bite, sting, are venomous or carry disease; or 2) plants poisonous by touch; or 3) pests that affect public works and other buildings if a person using the building could be at risk for their health or safety.

**Permits:** A person issued a permit by the Ministry may buy/use a pesticide as authorized by the permit.
